What is a Dental Implant?

Essentially, a dental implant is a small sturdy, titanium post that acts as the root would for a natural tooth. It is placed in the jawbone beneath the gum line, providing a base for a replacement tooth or teeth.

Over time, the implant fuses with the jawbone in a process called osseointegration, creating a stable foundation. This not only allows the implant to hold a replacement tooth or bridge firmly in place, but also helps maintain the jawbone's shape and density. The result is a durable and long-lasting solution that can help restore function and aesthetics making eating, speaking, and smiling feel completely natural again.

Is the Treatment Painful?

In the majority of cases, having a dental implant placed is much easier than you think. In fact most patients following the procedure report that having the tooth removed was worse!

For a simple case, the procedure can take less than half an hour and is carried out under local anaesthetic, usually requiring minimal pain relief afterwards. Patients normally return to work the next day.

How Long Before I Get a Tooth?

Treatment usually takes around four months. Where more advanced procedures are required, then it may take a little longer.

In some cases, 'immediate smile' treatment may even be an option. This is where the failing tooth or teeth are removed, and a new implant tooth is fitted the same day.

But Do Implants Last?

With proper care and maintenance, dental implants can last several decades. Our highly experienced dentists have placed over 3000 dental implants over the last 10 years, with an over 97% success rate.

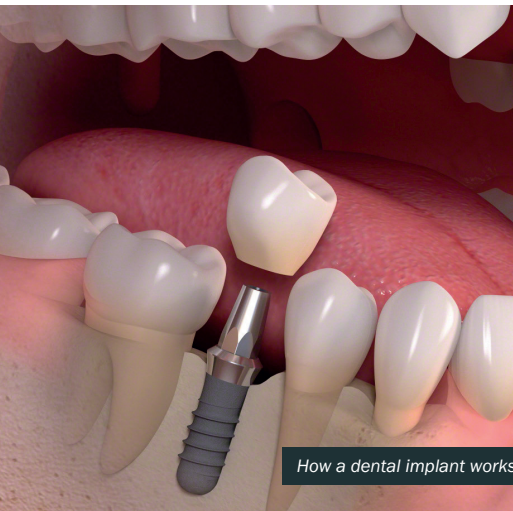
